The applicant should submit all the desired documents through the online application portal within the stipulated time. Non-submission of any document can result in disqualification of the application. Note: In case of insufficient income proofs, applicant may be asked for the following:

- a. If Parent(s) have business income, copy of certificate from CA/audited balance sheet and profit & loss account for FY 2022-23 & FY 2023-24.
- b. List of immovable properties and investments owned by the family along with approx. market value as on 31.3.2024.
